- Most DWI Arrests per Officer
- Most DWI Arrests per Police Department

Sheriff's Office Award - Awarded by LA Sheriffs' Association (Two awards per population grouping)

- Most DWI Arrests per Deputy
- Most DWI Arrest per Sheriff's Office

LWF Awards Statewide - Awarded by LWF Enforcement Division.

- Most DWI Arrests per District (Best District)

LSP Awards Statewide - Awarded by LSP.

- Most DWI Arrests per Trooper (Best Statewide Trooper)
- Most DWI Arrests per Troop (Best Troop)

Judicial Award - Awarded by Louisiana Judicial Association by a City or District Court (One award per population grouping)
